

Ruminating Relearn

How to make the Ruminating Relearn publication?

Install Etherpump

Make a virtual environment

```
$ python3 -m venv FOLDERNAME
```

activate the venv

```
$ . venv/bin/activate
```

Go to the publication.tools/etherdump folder.

```
$ cd publication.tools/etherpump
```

Install the dependencies of etherpump. The `-e` argument stands for “editable”. It will track any changes in the current python folder, and install it rightaway for you. Woosh!

```
$ pip install -e .
```

Check if etherpump is installed

```
$ etherpump --version
```

Initialize etherpump

```
$ etherpump init
```

You need to have access to the APIKEY of the etherpad instance that you use. This key can be found in the folder where the etherpad is installed on the server. There is a file there called APIKEY.txt. Copy the key and paste it in the prompt when

```
$ etherpump init
```

 asks for it.

Install other requirements

Go to the publication.tools folder

```
$ cd publication.tools
```

Install the other requirements

README

```
$ pip install -r requirements.txt
```

Have a look at the package you installed

```
$ pip freeze
```

Use the makefile to make the publication

Go to the Ruminating-Relearn folder

```
$ cd Ruminating-Relearn
```

To pull the latest version of the pads

```
$ make pull
```

To generate a new publication

```
$ make publication
```
